From North: South on I-71. Take exit #119B onto I-270 West toward Dayton. Go 9 miles. Take exit #17A onto US 33 E. toward Dublin, go .8 mile. Turn Right onto Frantz Rd. Go .7 miles. Turn Right onto Blazer Parkway. Go .6 miles to Ashland.

From South: North on I-71. Take exit #101 onto I-270 West. Go 16.2 miles. Take exit #15/Tuttle Crossing Blvd. Go .2 miles, turn Left on Blazer Parkway. Go .9 mile to Ashland.

From East: I-70 West toward Columbus. Take exit #93 onto I-270 North toward Cleveland. 6.9 miles. Take exit #15/Tuttle Crossing Blvd. Go .3 mile. Turn Right on Tuttle Crossing Blvd. Go .2 mile. Turn left on Blazer Parkway, go .9 mile to Ashland.

From West: I-70 East toward Columbus. Take exit #93B onto I-270 North toward Cleveland. Go 7 miles. Take exit #15/Tuttle Crossing Blvd. Go .3 mile. Turn Right on Tuttle Crossing Blvd. Go .2 mile. Turn Left on Blazer Parkway. Go .9 mile to Ashland.
