**James May** of Worthington, director of finance at DLZ Corp., received the 2005 Outstanding Member in Industry Award from the Ohio Society of CPAs.

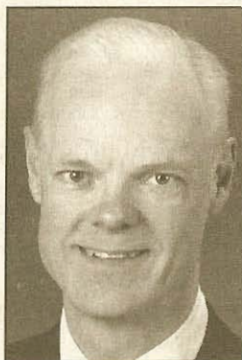
**Debbie Bailey**, a dental hygienist at the Worthington Dental Group, recently volunteered in the Ukraine to help spread dental awareness.

Eagon is president of Eagon & Associates, Inc.

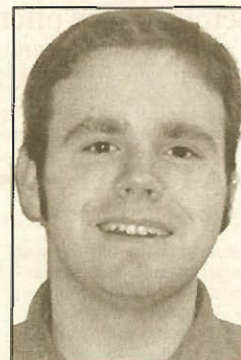
